## **Badminton Europe Summer School 2011**

Dear Member Associations.

We are delighted to announce that this year's Badminton Europe Summer School will take place in Madrid, Spain from 16 – 23 July 2011.

The Spanish Badminton Federation will host the event in its National Training Centre in the city centre of Madrid. It will be the first time that the BE Summer School stops in Madrid and just the second time it's going to take place in Spain.

With the 30th edition coming up, the Badminton Europe Summer School is the longest run development activity of Badminton Europe. We expected to welcome participants from almost all our Member Association's in Madrid to celebrate this jubilee!

The Badminton Europe Summer School is a one week training camp for junior players and their coaches. There will be a Coach Education course for participant coaches. The course will be based on the rewritten Badminton Europe Coach Education material.

There is limited space at the Badminton Europe Summer School. In recent years we have received massive interest from Member Associations in nominating participants. It is possible that we receive more nominations than available places.

A Confederation of Badminton World Federation

Every Member Association is invited to nominate up to 6 players and 4 coaches. However it is important that these are ranked in order of preference in case only 2 players or 2 coaches per country can be accepted. To have balanced participation Badminton Europe would welcome to receive nominations of equal numbers of female and male players and coaches.

Therefore nominating a participant does not guarantee entry. We want to ensure your players and coaches' benefit as much as possible from the staff's coaching and we do not want the badminton courts to become overcrowded.

Please use the attached forms for making nominations. There are separate forms for players and participating coaches.

We hope that the Summer School will once again be a success and even more European Member Associations will choose to participate.

The closing date for submitting nominations is **15 April 2011**. Badminton Europe will then try to confirm accepted participants until 2 May 2011.
